

The Union has the following as its principal objectives:-

- Unionization of workers in the Textile, Garment & Tailoring Industries throughout the country.
- Unionisation of Tailors, Garment Producers and Tie and Dye Makers (Kampala) throughout the country.
- Regulation of the relations between workers and employers and between the workmen and workmen
- Establishment and maintenance of just and proper hours of work, rates or pay, and conditions of service.
- Encouragement and maintenance of high standard of production in the establishment.
- Educational and training opportunities for members
- Fight against high taxation, and harassment of members by govt.
- Provide the opportunity for collective action on issues affecting members
- Negotiate protection against harassment of members by government agents
- Provision of benefits and other assistance to members as provided in the constitution.
- Encouragement of the participation of workers in an undertaking; Industry and at national level
- Protection and advancement of the socio-economic and cultural interest of the members and Such other objectives as are lawful and are not inconsistent with the spirit and practice of Trade Unionism.
- Improve wages and protect the industry
- Fight against unfair labour practices and ensure decent jobs

- Forty-Six (46) signed National Collective Agreement on wages and allowances
- Thousands of signed Branch Agreement
- Abolished casual jobs in the Textile Industry
- Training and re-training of members
- Fought for the protection of the industry which led to bail-out fund

- Strong internal democracy practice (regular branch, Zonal & National Election)
- Reviewed constitution to implement gender equity policy of NLC
